“To discover and share knowledge about plants and their environment in order to preserve and enrich life.”

The United Nations designated 2011 the International Year of Forests to raise global awareness as well as encourage conservation and sustainable development and management of all types of forests now and in the future. According to World Bank estimates, more than 1.6 billion people depend on forests for their livelihoods, and yet the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) estimates that every year 130,000 km² of the world's forests are lost through conversion to agricultural land, unsustainable timber harvesting, unwise land management practices, and other threatening factors.

Forests provide habitats to about two-thirds of all species on earth, and deforestation of these habitats could account for biodiversity loss of as many as 100 species a day. At the Missouri Botanical Garden, researchers across the globe and in St. Louis are working against time to document plant species and habitats and to conserve biodiversity. In St. Louis, we are accelerating our efforts to research, collect, propagate, and safeguard rare and endangered species and to provide a home for the living collections that help us understand the world of plants that surrounds us.



One of the ways the Missouri Botanical Garden contributes to this global effort is through sharing of research findings and other information. This happens primarily through publications and when Garden staff members attend international conferences to present their research. But occasionally the Garden is able to play the host. In July the Garden held the 2011 Conference of the Global Partnership for Plant Conservation, which is working to accomplish 16 targets for plant conservation by 2020. The conference attracted more than 100 plant conservationists from around the world to share their experiences and further the development of plant conservation. In October the Garden welcomed the directors of three botanical gardens in China for a ceremonial signing of a memorandum of understanding to encourage our ongoing collaboration among the four institutions.

The U.N. theme for the year is central to our work, our concerns, and the vision of the Garden. Trees and forests are important cornerstones, without which much of the world's biodiversity would be lost. The next time you come to the Garden, please consider taking a minute to linger beneath one of our many old and historic trees and give thanks for all the benefits that trees and other natural habitats provide.

This year Missouri Botanical Garden researchers marked several milestones as well as a series of "first evers." Among the milestones, the Madidi Project in Bolivia celebrated its 10-year anniversary, and as of 2011 had registered 8,500 species in the floristic inventory.



As a contributor to the Global Observational Research Initiative in Alpine Environments (GLORIA), the Garden continued its long-term intensive ecological and botanical assessment of alpine sites across the Himalayan Mountains. Two new sites were added in 2011: one in western Nepal's Annapurna Conservation Area and another in central Bhutan's Wangchuck Centennial Park.





Less a “first ever” than a “hardly ever,” the Missouri Botanical Garden also played a significant role in identifying a new genus, *Yasunia*, with two confirmed species from Ecuador and Peru, *Y. quadrata* and *Y. sessiliflora*. While hundreds of new plant species are identified each year, new genera are extremely uncommon, and having two separate confirmed species makes *Yasunia* a very distinctive discovery.



In 2011 the Garden’s Center for Biodiversity Informatics (CBI) joined members of the Biodiversity Heritage Library (BHL) consortium, the Cambridge University Library, the Darwin Manuscripts Project at the American Museum of Natural History in New York, and the Natural History Museum in London in a collaborative effort to digitize the personal scientific library of Charles Darwin. The collaboration marks the first time that notes and comments written by Darwin on the pages and margins of his own personal library will be available online. The CBI built the technology components needed to deliver Darwin’s digitized library and handwritten annotations to users all over the world.



Under the leadership of new Vice President of Horticulture, Andrew Wyatt, the Garden spent much of 2011 building capacity and documenting and assessing our living collections. The Horticulture team began assessing and transforming greenhouse spaces to acquire and house more live collections. Working with researchers in several areas, including the Caucasus and China, the greenhouses will be better able to house live specimens for propagation and further research to expand the knowledge base and collections of plant species around the world.




Plant cultivation also has a technical side, and in 2011 the Garden began core work on a massive living collections database. Once complete, this database will be comparable to the Garden's other plant database, Tropicos. Ongoing work with GIS mapping in the Garden added locations for the irrigation systems and donor benches.






On grounds, members of the Horticulture staff completed 10% of a comprehensive tree canopy assessment in order to help the Garden plan short-term and long-term management of our tree collection. The assessment tracks potential hazards; documents historic, rare, or endangered trees; checks for signs of disease; and notes the trees' sizes.



The Linnean House restoration, completed in April, returned part of the historic building back to its original use as an orangery where visitors can enjoy rare and behind-the-scenes plants like citrus trees and specimens from the cactus collection.



The Garden continues to attract thousands of visitors, both young and old, to connect with nature, cultivate an interest in science and conservation, and learn about sustainable ways to live through participation in a variety of educational programs and classes. One new and popular class was the rare plants tour led by the Vice President of Horticulture, Andrew Wyatt.





In recognition of the U.N. International Year of Forests, the Garden worked to increase public awareness of the connections between healthy forests, ecosystems, and people. In addition to year-round classes and speaker/film events for adults and families, visitors to the Garden were able to explore and discover Extreme Tree Houses and play and learn in the TREEmendous Interactive Discovery Center in the Brookings Interpretive Center. National Arbor Day was celebrated with a well-attended Forest Festival, featuring tree-inspired food, music, demonstrations, and even the opportunity for people to climb up into the Garden's canopy!

In addition to the popular rare plant tour, the Garden added a number of other classes in 2011, including a sold-out tour of the rare and historic trees of the Garden. In anticipation of the Garden's 2012 Lantern Festival, several new classes with East Asian themes were added in 2011. Middle- and high-school-aged students explored the Chinese and Japanese Gardens, comparing and contrasting the elements that exemplify each garden type as well as their specific flora.





Butterflies, perhaps more than any species, remind us of the connection between plants and animals. As pollinators, they fulfill an essential role in the life cycle of plants. In addition, they are a delight to watch as they make their way from one plant to the next. More than 50,000 butterflies made their first flights at the Sophia M. Sachs Butterfly House. Nearly 30,000 Garden members visited the Butterfly House in 2011, while the signature event, March Morpho Mania, alone attracted 30,000 visitors. A recent addition to the events schedule, October Owls and Orchids saw 2,000 visitors. The Butterfly House added a third show for the holidays, Snow in the Tropics, which featured a winter wonderland of snowy kite butterflies amid a tropical orchid display; 2,500 visitors attended this first-ever event.



Of course butterflies are found in large and concentrated numbers at the Butterfly House, but they are also abundant at the Shaw Nature Reserve, along with native wildflowers, tall grass prairies, wetlands, glades, and other habitats that host them and hundreds of other species that make the Nature Reserve their home. Teaching people about native plants has always been on the agenda at the Nature Reserve, and the Native Plant School increased its participation in 2011 while the Shaw Professional Landscape Series held steady.



Although the 2,400-acre Nature Reserve is known for its natural native beauty, the built environment is an important element. The Edgar Anderson Center at the Nature Reserve was constructed in 2010, and in 2011 was awarded the LEED Gold certification by the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) for water efficiency, energy efficiency, lighting and equipment efficiency, and on-site renewable energy. During construction, over 96 percent of the on-site generated construction waste was diverted from landfills.





...at the Garden

The Missouri Botanical Garden continues to advance our efforts to go green, which includes the responsible use of resources such as energy, water, building materials, business supplies, and fuel. Some of the questions we ask ourselves include: How can we operate a world class botanical garden utilizing the least amount of energy and water while producing a minimal amount of waste? How do we transfer our waste into something usable? How do we increase our use of clean energy sources?

The Garden has earned LEED certification for two additional Garden facilities, Spink Pavilion at the main campus and the Edgar Anderson Center at Shaw Nature Reserve. The Commerce Bank Center for Science Education was awarded Energy Star certification.

We increased our food waste composting and recycling collection at Garden events and in Sassafra's café. Water bottle filling stations have also been installed in four locations at the Garden, reducing the demand for bottled water.

We've also made it easier to participate in our sustainability efforts by educating our visitors with onsite signage, a robust Sustainability/Conservation section on the website, and an array of sustainable products available at the Garden Gate Shop.



...in the community

The Garden also provides assistance to make energy efficiency work for homeowners. EarthWays Center, a department of the Garden and part of the Sustainability Division, reaches businesses and institutions and the professionals associated with serving those audiences through ongoing involvement with over 69 local businesses in the Regional Chamber & Growth Association's Green Business Challenge, Residential Energy Efficiency Programs, and U.S. Green Building Council. Through our work with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and St. Louis County, more than \$4 million was spent on improving the homes of our region with \$1.6 million given in rebates, \$1 million given in loans, and well over \$1.5 million leveraged from over 310 homeowners. Through work with Ameren Illinois and Conservation Services Group, over 520 home energy audits were done. Over 50 contractors have been trained or certified in local energy efficiency programs, supporting the green jobs economy in our bi-state region.



The Green Homes & Great Health Festival was held at the Garden for the first time in its ten-year history, establishing it as a new Garden signature event. More than 4,000 attendees visited over 100 displays and demonstrations, green marketplace and food vendors, health exhibitors, children's activities, and workshops.

Funding for EarthWays Center Sustainability Education green schools programs doubled in 2011, and outreach programs reached twice as many participants as in 2010, thereby doubling the reach of sustainability education on behalf of the Garden.





In the 21st century, electronic media are the new public face of an institution. It was with this in mind that the Garden undertook a complete overhaul of its public website. In addition to a back-end reconfiguration, the design was updated and modernized, and navigation was improved. Both Shaw Nature Reserve and the Butterfly House sites were updated in concert with the main site as well.




In conjunction with our TREEmendous event, The Great St. Louis Tree Hunt highlighted 30 notable and significant trees throughout the greater St. Louis bi-state region and encouraged everyone to get out and find them. Each tree was geocached and featured a scannable QR code, encouraging visitors to use GPS technology and the web to locate the trees, learn more about them, and compete with others to find them all. More than 2,000 geocache "finds" were recorded throughout the Hunt, including this one: *"16 of 17 found today on a quest for ten more TREEmendous caches and a trip to Botanical Garden...first time I've been to the Garden...quite a place..."*

The Missouri Botanical Garden received a grant for over \$500,000 from the Department of Interior, National Park Service (NPS) through the Save America's Treasures (SAT) grant program. The funds are being used for the preservation and rehabilitation of a section of the Garden's historic stone east perimeter wall, which was built around 1856. The 9- to 12-foot-tall limestone wall has been compromised and is deteriorating due to a combination of age, weather, and internal structural failure, among other factors. The grant allows the Garden to restore this portion of the wall as closely as possible to its original condition, so that it may continue to provide site security and historic continuity for years to come.




